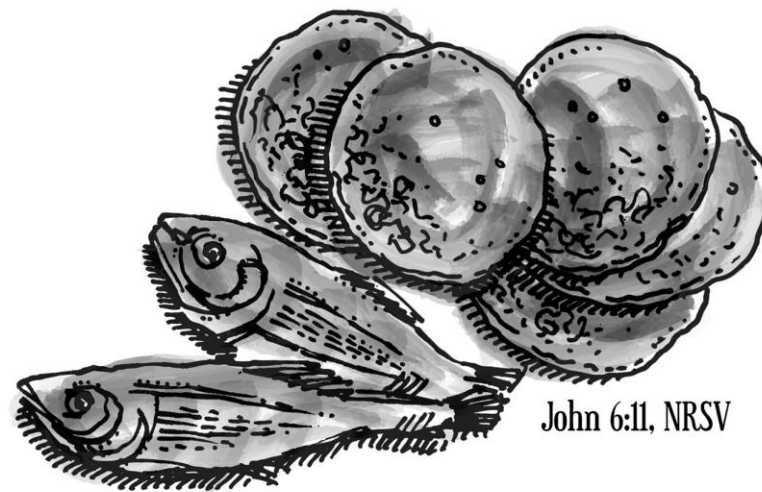
### Missions & Community
